Congratulations to Alexandra Lee, PhD, MSPH for receiving a UCSF Resource Allocation Program (RAP) for the FY2025 cycle! The project entitled "Use of SGLT2 inhibitors and GLP1 receptor agonists in Nursing Home Residents with Diabetes" aims to describe trends from 2020 to 2023 in the use of SGLT2 and GLP1 compared to other second-line therapies among NH residents with T2DM and characterize NH residents in 2020-2023 who do and do not receive SGLT2i and GLP-1RA medications. Dr. Lee will work closely with Sei Lee, MD, MAS on this study, which will provide important foundational preliminary data for subsequent grant proposals, including an NIH Research Project Grant (R01). Congratulations again Dr. Lees!



Last year, Drs. Patricia Bloom and Harrison Bloom presented to the UCSF Division of Geriatrics about their Kisoro Elders Project to help older adults in Uganda and this week they reached out to share that they have published a report on this project in the online global health journal, Global Health and Economic Sustainability (read abstract).

They also have now established The Center for Aging in Uganda at Kisoro District Hospital, with a mission to be a resource center for other communities seeking to help older adults and an advocacy center for improved health and social services for older adults in Uganda.


