

The newly renovated Talking Books and Braille Center (TBBC) is associated with the National Library Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped (NLS) at the Library of Congress and offers complimentary library services to San Francisco residents facing challenges accessing printed materials due to visual impairments or print disabilities. Registered members can check out talking books, braille books, and audio-described DVDs. Additionally, a range of assistive technologies, such as computers, desktop video magnifiers, scanning and reading software, and a Braille embosser, are provided for use. Every month, TBBC hosts various community events including book clubs, a writer's salon, a Spanishlanguage music appreciation group, and personalized technical support sessions.
