

GERI CHRONICLES COOKBOOK


Food has a way of bringing people together and offering comfort and connection. Each week in GeriNews, we will share a recipe from our Geri Kitchen Chronicles Cookbook, comprised of recipes that our Division members love to make and share. Try this quick and easy weeknight recipe: <u>Baked Macaroni by Jordan</u> Werner!



Chef's Notes

As a family of 8 (6 daughters), my grandmother had a big family to feed on a budget. This recipe, although simple, is a quick, cheap, and hardy meal with a generous serving. Our family does not come from a long line of chefs so this recipe is one of the few things we can masterfully cook, and it is one that we have all come to know and love. From our family to yours, I hope you enjoy it as much as we do!



- 1. You will need a 13x9 baking dish, cheese grater, can opener and a pot to boil the noodles.
- Start by setting the oven to 350 degrees.
- Boil 6 cups water in a large pot or a deep pan and bring it to boil over medium flame. When it comes to rolling boil, add noodles, Boil until noodles are soft, Stir occasionally in between.
- Turn off the flame and transfer it to colander to drain excess water. Pour 1-2 cups cold water over boiled noodles and drain again to remove excess stickiness.
- 5. Open the Mushroom soup cans and add them all to a microwave safe bowl, place in microwave for 3-5 minutes. This allows for easier mixing.
 6. Combine noodles and warm cream of mushroom soup into the 13x9 baking pan, mix thoroughly, making sure to coat all noodles. Feel free to add
- an extra can of cream of mushroom soup if you want it creamier.

 7. Grate block of cheddar cheese (sharp or mild) and cover the top of the noodle and soup mixture, Add as much or as little cheese as desired.
- 8. Place dish in oven and bake for 30-45 minutes, bake until cheese is all melted. For added crunch leave in oven longer
- Take out oven, turn oven off and let cool before serving.
