

on GitHub Pages

This hands-on workshop teaches students, faculty and staff the basics around promoting oneself professionally online. Attendees will learn about approaches to sharing their research on social media, on digital scholarship platforms like OrchidID or Google Scholar, and elsewhere on the web. In addition to this conceptual practice, attendees will learn the basics of GitHub pages, and use a template to prepare a free, professional-looking, public curriculum vitae (CV) on the GitHub platform, which they will be able to use to promote their work online.
